Overview and Purpose

Skate Canada sets guidelines for the skater-to-coach ratio during CanSkate sessions and has the expectation that Program Assistants (PAs) will help to assist in the delivery of the CanSkate and PreCanSkate programs.

Program Assistant Training is offered once a year and it is designed to help you grow as a skater, person, and a leader. The training includes professional course material, providing valuable insights on working with children of different personalities. You will gain hands-on experience in your assigned roles and responsibilities including demonstrating techniques and helping to lead warm-ups and cool-downs. You will get to know the Skate Canada's CanSkate program from a leadership perspective.

Who needs to attend?

PA Training is <u>MANDATORY</u> for All PreSTAR Group and STARSkaters registered in the IESC programs, who are 10 years of age or older. For STARSKaters who are younger than 10, attendance is optional.

PA training will equip the attendees with the skills and information they need to assist the coaches on-ice during the PreCanSkate and CanSkate Sessions throughout the 2025/2026 Season.

How are PAs scheduled?

You will be assigned to a Thursday or Sunday Canskate class through the session and this PA schedule will be shared with you in advance. Please respond to the PA survey e-mailed to you prior to the start of the CanSkate session at which time you will be able to identify the day of the week that you prefer to assist or known dates that you are not available. You are required to find a sub for yourself from the list that will be provided.

PA Responsibilities:

- 1. Setup and put away equipment and props/toys
- 2. Lead the warm up and cool down
- 3. Rotate groups
- 4. Demonstrate techniques and skills on the trails
- 5. Hand out stickers, ribbons, report cards, colouring sheets
- 6. Be a leader
- 7. Smile and give praise and encouragement
- 8. Help skaters build confidence
- 9. Follow the directions of lead Canskate coaches at all times Must stay assigned with the groups it is not time to practice your own skating skills.
- 10. Find your own sub when away or sick

PA training is free and held each September.

Current PAs are asked to join again, even if you attended before, to refresh and strengthen the skills listed here and to further enhance leadership abilities.
